With respect to last week's communications, we noticed some inconsistencies in our points regarding COVID-19 Industry Wide Health Directions. First and foremost, we apologize for any confusion or inconvenience this may have caused. Please refer to the below directions with respect to travel outside of Canada and the following additional criteria under which employees need to quarantine or isolate and NOT report to work or Dispatch:

- Employees who have been diagnosed with COVID-19;
- Employees who have symptoms of COVID-19;
- Employees who are living or in an intimate relationship with someone who has COVID-19;
- Employees who are caring for someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19;
- Employees who have received a recommendation from a Canadian government agency, health authority, or public health official to isolate due to COVID-19 concerns and health directions.
