

Government Removal of COVID-19 Measures effective October 1, 2022

The Government of Canada has <u>removed all COVID-19 entry restrictions</u>, as well as testing, quarantine, and isolation requirements for anyone entering Canada, effective October 1, 2022.

Cruise measures are also lifted, and travellers will no longer be required to have preboard tests, be vaccinated, or use ArriveCAN.

As of October 1, 2022, longshore workers, and those boarding cruise vessels, will no longer be required to be fully vaccinated to work cruise or board the vessel.
